

**Mufti at MAC  
(NAG 5)**

**Rationale:**

It is a privilege for Year 12 and 13 students at MAC to wear mufti for their final two years at school. This policy is designed to respect an individual's autonomy, individual dignity and right to freedom of expression. However, the senior students must be aware and respect that MAC is a learning institution with a diverse range of students and staff, and must take that into consideration when making clothing choices.

**Purpose:**

Appropriate dress sense, and awareness of the expectations of the community should be fostered by everyone at MAC. A meeting will be held at the beginning of 2020 to allow students and staff to agree dress standards for 2020. Once the code has been agreed the school reserves the right to decide whether standards of personal dress and grooming are acceptable and to take appropriate action when standards are not met.

Please see below for a set of guidelines that are designed to provide clarity to this document and make yourself familiar with them:

1. Clothing worn is to be clean, tidy and in good condition.
2. Clothing should not carry offensive messages/pictures or slogans related to alcohol or drugs.
3. Students must adhere to the health and safety requirements in specialist classrooms. E.g. enclosed shoes must be worn in science labs, food technology and materials technology areas.
4. Discrete makeup or jewellery can be worn at school.
5. Facial hair, facial piercings and visible tattoos are not permitted.
6. Items of cultural or religious significance require senior management approval.

Failure to comply will be handled as per the Behaviour Management Policy.
