UNIFORM

COLOUR

Three colour “stories” from Argyle were tabled. Unfortunately the printed colours did not come out true to the palettes.

- A. Blue, white and grey
- B. Black and gold story
- C. Natural environment story

The plan is to put the “stories” in the windows of UR space for the community to see at the awards ceremonies, with a view to surveying opinion, which will be ranking A, B and C. It is important that the community are clear that we are only surveying colour not style at this point, Wayne would make this clear in his speeches, and the pictures provided per colour story should compare the same styles so as not to distract from the colour palettes.

There was some concern that the printed colours did not come out true to the actual colour palettes, this will need to be resolved before displaying. Shona had gathered some historic photo information of the school uniform and it was agreed these should be included.

SHOES

Draft policy circulated. Shoe enforcement came up a lot in the focus groups, but it was felt that any policy on this should be left until the full change of uniform, which we are anticipating to start 2020 for Year 7s. The current policy should be adhered to consistently.

MUFTI GUIDELINES

A draft had been tabled as in the previous Board meeting. Liz Breslin provided some other options. The Wellington High School option was read out. It was agreed that some of the options could be added to our current policy.

It was felt that the original option was too specific and very hard to police. The more general option was preferred, no change at this point.

OTHER ITEMS

- Boys wanted a change of sock, but will leave until full uniform change.
- Polyprops, agreed to allow white for girls, grey for boys.
- Students will be able to wear a puffer of their choice
- Sunsmart to be a focus for 2019. Sunhats to be strongly recommended and modelled. A uniform hat option could be implemented before the main roll out. Sunscreen is available at school but will be made more visible. Skin Alive may wish to support the school regarding sunscreen.
