



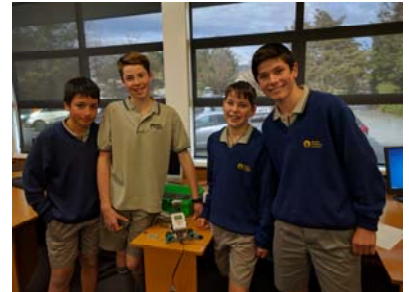
High Vis Day at the Clyde Dam

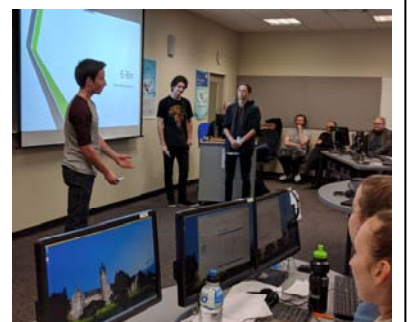
